STEP 1 | ANSWER THE CALL

DID GOD REALLY PICK ME?! | STEP 1 - PART 1 & 2



Do you really believe God has purpose for you? The answer should be YES because far before you were even conceived, God had a plan for your life. Whether you know the details or not, God has purpose for you! You might feel unworthy, unqualified, or unsure, but the Word of God shows from beginning to end, purpose is older, bigger, and greater than you. 2 Timothy 2:9 assures us that God "hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began." Knowing everything, God saves and calls us with a reason, and that reason is His own purpose and grace! Now is the time to find, fulfill, and finish the work God has purposed for you in the earth.

STEP 2 | LIVE HOLY

WHAT LIFESTYLE DOES GOD REQUIRE? | STEP 2 - PART 1



Throughout the Bible, God used people on both sides of the equation for His purpose and plan. Whether Pharaoh stubbornly fighting the people of God & setting the stage for God's signs and wonders to be multiplied (Exo. 11:9) or Peter preaching the first message of the church after many mistakes (Acts 2:14-41), God can use all kinds of people for His glory. If you are on the Lord's side, though, there is a lifestyle that is required by God when we're wholeheartedly working in His service. He came to save His people from sin, freeing us from the darkness that would destroy us. He changes us from who we used to be, making us new (2 Cor. 5:17), and then He empowers and expects us to walk in holiness, set apart for His purpose. Our daily actions should line up with His Word and please Him, as we live so He can use us anytime or anywhere.

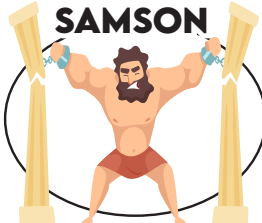
