OUTLINE STEP 3: STUDY THE OUTLINE

DEFINITIONS: WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

- A. Repent Old Testament (Hebrew)
 - 1. **Nacham** (*naw-kham*') Gen. 6:6
 - a. Strong's No. 5162: to sigh, breathe strongly; impl. to be sorry



- c. The Hebrew Pictographs:
 - i. NUN: Fish/Seed (Life, Activity) Gen. 1:26-31
 - ii. CHET: Fence/Wall (Separate, Cut off from) Gen. 6:6-7
 - iii. MEM: Water (Might (concealed), Chaos) Gen. 6:5 Note: When God "repented" (Gen. 6:6) there was a cutting off, separation: 'Done!' Hence the word "Destroy" (Gen. 6:7); from 'Emcheh (אמחה). Before this man was kept, strengthened, sustained and enabled by God. Compare this with God's intent re: the Children of Israel (Exo. 32:10-14).
- d. Repent" is from the Hebrew word Nacham (naw-kham'). Nacham □nı= Noah nı (meaning "Comfort; Comforter"; Gen. 5:29) + Mem □ ("Water").

Note: Similarly, the result of Repentance today is the "Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost" (John 14:26) + Water Baptism in Jesus Name (Acts 2:38 Cp. Luke 24:47).

- 2. **Shuwb** (*shoob*)
 - a. The first use of the Hebrew word Shuwb is Genesis 3:19 (<u>Cp</u>. Acts 3:19). It is used twice as "Repent" Ezek. 14:6; 18:30
 - b. Strong's No. 7725: *turn back (to starting point)*, *sigh*, *convert*, *deliver*, *rescue*, *restore* (*wife*; Gen. 20:7), *return* (*to dust*; Gen. 3:19 Cp. Acts 3:19)
 - c. The Hebrew Letters: שובו = Shin (ש) + Vau (ו) + Beth (ב) +
