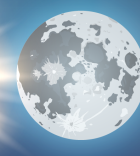

THE FIRST DAY OF THE WEEK



BY THE START OF SUNDAY MORNING, JESUS HAD ALREADY RISEN

- The women came...
 - as it began to dawn (Mat. 28:1)
 - at the rising of the sun (Mark 16:2)
 - very early in the morning (Luke 24:1)
 - while it was yet dark (John 20:1)
- They brought spices (Mark 16:1; Luke 24:1) but they could not find the body of Jesus (Luke 24:3; John 20:2).
- The angel tells them, "He is not here: for he is risen, as he said" (Mat. 28:6 cp. Luke 24:6).

3 DAYS & 3 NIGHTS IN THE TOMB

Wed approx. 6 pm-Thurs 6 pm = 1 day | Thurs 6 pm-Fri 6 pm = 2 days | Fri 6 pm-Sat approx. 6 pm = 3 days

H O U R S

- Day starts at 6 am
- 3rd Hour - 9 am
- 6th Hour - 12 noon
- 9th Hour - 3 pm

D A Y S

- Days: Evening & Morning (Gen. 1:5)**
- Evening & night ~6 pm to ~6 am
 - Morning & day: ~6 am to ~6 pm
- Sabbath: Even to Even (Lev. 23:32)**
- New Sabbath Started ~6 pm
